Shri Narendra Modi Ji, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Government of India.

Subject: National Health Emergency in light of COVID-21

Respected Hon'ble Prime Minister,

We at the Health Parliament – A Think Tank on Evidence-Based Policymaking, wish to draw your attention to the situation arising due to COVID-21, which is more devastating than the COVID-19.

Considering the gravity of the situation and the likelihood of COVID-21 cases touching between 3 to 5 lac per day or even more, in such a situation, there could be an extreme shortage of medicines, equipment and beds. We have to take planned steps considering the worst possible scenario in mind, and hence, at the Health Parliament, we felt it appropriate to request you to declare National Health Emergency without any further delay. We request you to consider the following steps amongst others;

- Fund the private sector for catering to the needs of medicine, beds and equipment
- Calling in the forces (military) to create temporary hospitals using the vast railways and the train network. Synergies with Container Corporation of India should be explored for setting up temporary facilities.
- Order the PSUs in pharmaceuticals and the hospital construction (HCC) sector to manufacture according to the needs and factor in extra capacity.
- If some medicines are covered by patents, please use the clause of compulsory licensing to start manufacturing these medicines.
- We urge you to allocate medicines through AMRUT & Jan Aushadi stores, and the eprescriptions should be allowed to be serviced by postal services and courier, so that we restrict people's movement and urge them to stay indoors.
- Though medicine exports have been stopped, any vaccine export and other related equipment be stopped with immediate effect.
- Time restrictions on shops and establishments and transport be lifted for essential supplies.
